Dear Sir/Madame:

Re: Proposed Sidewalk Construction

The Corporation of the District of Saanich would like to inform you that, as part of the 2014 Capital Works Program, we will be constructing a concrete sidewalk on the south side of Cedar Avenue from Shelbourne Street to Thistle Street.

Construction is scheduled to begin in mid November, 2014 and may be complete by mid December, pending favourable weather conditions. During the construction period you can expect a crew and equipment to be on site between the hours of 8:00 am and 4:00 pm. During these hours, single, alternating traffic may be in effect. We kindly ask that you follow the instructions of the traffic control and / or construction personnel.

The District of Saanich will be responsible for the restoration of the construction area and will try to minimize any inconvenience to you during the ongoing construction period. Some driveways, however, will need to be closed for a few days in order to allow the concrete to cure. In these cases, you will receive advanced notice from the on-site crew.
