The UVic Behavioural Medicine Lab, under the direction of Dr. Ryan Rhodes, is currently conducting a large-scale study that is looking to determine what are some of the most successful strategies that can be used to help families to increase their physical activity levels. To be eligible, families must have at least one child between the ages of 6 and 12 who is getting less than 60 minutes of moderate-to-vigorous physical activity each day. The study is 6 months long with 5 check-in points during that time frame and families will receive various resources to help increase their physical activity levels.
